CTPD News Letter Summer 2017

1. Remember, when swimming in Lake Michigan, you are swimming at your own risk. Please visit: www.ripcurrent.noaa.gov for additional information on rip currents, rip current safety tips, and how to spot rip currents. Our office and the Township Hall have safety pamphlets available, which were funded by The Pokagon Fund. Please stop by and pick one up for you or your family.
2. Remember your neighbors when having a party or social gathering, playing loud music, or shooting off fireworks. For additional information on the Good Neighbor Policy of the Township, please click home, and then click on the link for the Good Neighbor Policy. Review the information on the Township's Noise Ordinance against loud and excessive noises.
3. Remember, should you park in a "No Parking Zone," or park any part of your vehicle on a traveled portion of a roadway, you may be ticketed and/or your vehicle towed. Moreover, do not park either partially or fully blocking someone's driveway, and do not park within 15-feet of a fire hydrant.
4. Remember the rights of private beach owners. Should you visit one of the Township's Road End Beaches this summer, stay within the public beach and DO NOT encroach or sit on a privately owned beach. One may be asked to leave by the property owner and/or a police officer. Failure to leave private property may result in one being prosecuted criminally. Signs have been displayed that exhibit where the public beaches ends and where private beaches begin.
5. Remember, for health and safety reasons, when visiting our beaches, please pick up your trash and put it into the trash receptacles. Do not leave trash on the beaches, or laying around the trash receptacles, or along the roadways.
6. Also for health and safety reasons, an ordinance exists what prohibits dogs from being on a public beach. People violating this ordinance may be cited under local ordinance and may be forced to pay a fine.
